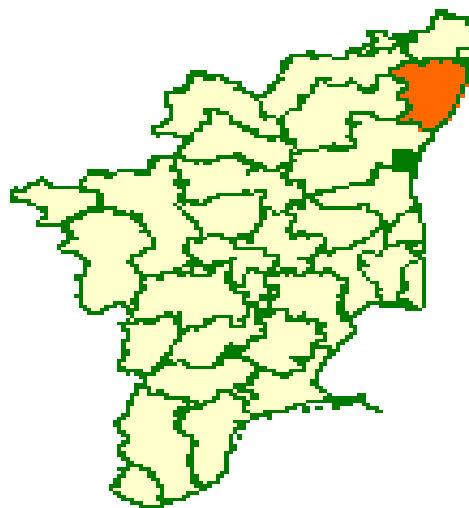
LOCATION OF THE DISTRICT:

District Profile

1. General Profile

Kanchipuram District lies between 11°00' to 12°00' north latitudes and 77°28' to 78°50' east longitudes in Tamilnadu State. This district comprises of 1,214 revenue villages, eight taluks and 13 blocks.

The total geographical area of the district is 4,433 sq.km. and is endowed with a coastline of 57 kms.



The district boundaries are:

East: Bay of Bengal
West: Vellore and Thiruvannamalai District
North: Chennai and Tiruvallur District
South: Villupuram District and Pondicherry.
